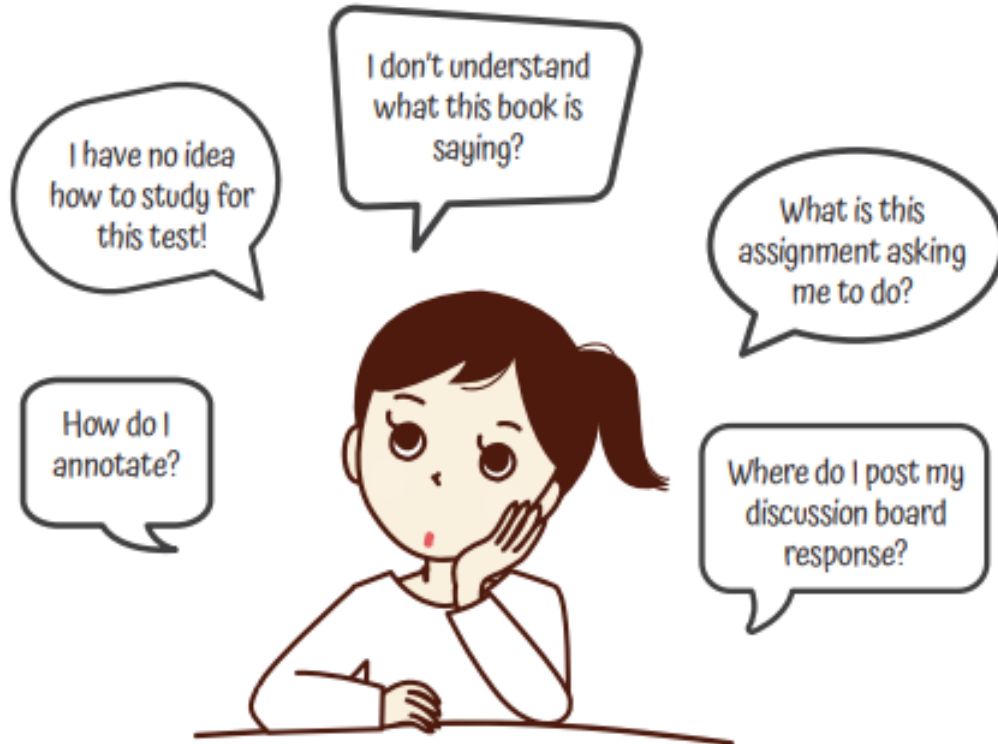



You can receive up to **\$400** for your participation in this study.

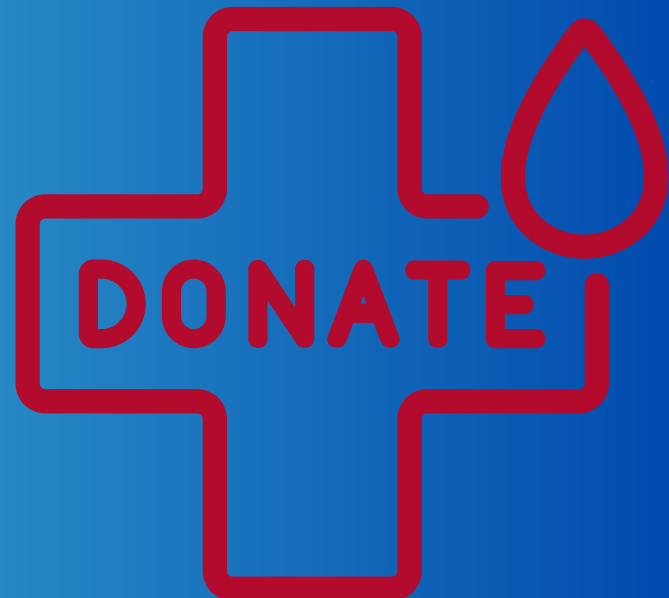
