



Radiologic Technology Getting Started Checklist

We are committed to helping you achieve your goals! Follow the steps on this guide to apply for the Radiologic Technology Program. A review of your academic performance and the following requirements are utilized to score your admission placement in the program.

This program offers courses in a face-to-face and online format. New students are admitted every **Fall semester**.

- Full Time: Every Fall semester
Fall Semester: Apply February 1st – March 15th

Program Acceptance:

Applications will be reviewed when ALL requirements are submitted AND pre-requisite courses are completed. Please note the following:

- Applicants with courses in progress will not be reviewed for acceptance until the end of the term AND after the submission of all requirements.
- Applicants **MUST** resubmit all documentation during each application period.

Getting Started:

Are you currently an SCC student enrolled in classes at SCC?

For students currently enrolled in a program at SCC and/or working on pre-requisite courses for a Health Sciences program please meet with your assigned College Advisor. If this is your first term at SCC you will be connected with your advisor after completing *New Student Enrollment*. Are you new to SCC or unsure where to start?

If you are new to SCC or have not completed the required program pre-requisite courses listed below, please submit an Application for Admission to the Associate of Health Sciences program at www.southeast.edu/applynow. If you need help determining your next step, please contact admissions@southeast.edu for assistance.

Demonstrate Appropriate Level of Proficiency in Reading and/or Math

- Must have completed ENGL 1010
 - Must have completed MATH 1100 or higher or place into MATH 1150 or higher
- Proficiency can be demonstrated with placement test scores OR course completion. For details related to placement testing or to schedule a placement test go to <https://www.southeast.edu/nextgenerationaccuplacer/>.

Complete Program Pre-Requisite Requirements: Students must receive a grade point average of 2.75 for the sciences (Anatomy & Physiology) and 2.5 general education courses for admission into the program. Submit official transcripts showing college coursework completed at a college/university other than SCC, to SCC Admissions Office 8800 O Street Lincoln, NE 68520.



Students are eligible to apply for the program once the following required courses are completed. See college catalog for specific course requirements.

- Human Anatomy with Lab (within past 5 years)
- Human Physiology with Lab (within past 5 years)
- Introduction to Sociology
- Speech Communications
- Written Communications
- Success at SCC

*Please note that combined Anatomy and Physiology courses (i.e. Anatomy and Physiology I and II) with labs are eligible for evaluation to meet program requirements.

Fall Semester (August): Please apply February 1st – March 15th.
 - First review of completed applications will begin on March 15th; the application will remain open until all program seats are full.
 - Notification of acceptance will occur **on or after** April 15th.
Incomplete applications will not be reviewed if missing program requirements.
- Complete Clinical Requirements:** Submit the following during the application period. Submit documentation to the Health Sciences Building (HSB 230) or email: healthsciences@southeast.edu.
 - Proof of current CPR for Basic Life Support (BLS) Healthcare Providers American Heart Association **only**
 - Complete Student Health Statement (see documentation form on program website)
 - Complete current Tuberculosis two-step skin test (see documentation form on program website)
