FEDERAL STUDENT LOAN BORROWERS BE ON THE LOOKOUT IF YOU ARE GRADUATING OR FALL BELOW 6 CREDIT HOURS

EXIT Counseling is **REQUIRED** for any student who has received Federal Direct Student Loans at SCC and drops below 6 credit hours or has completed a program (graduated). This counseling is designed to assist students with understanding their rights and responsibilities that apply to their loan. Information covered in Exit Counseling: Loan Repayment Plan, Repayment Options, Deferment & Forbearance Options, Cancellation Options, Loan Consolidation & Rehabilitation, Prepayment Information, and Consequences of Default on loan and service obligation.
